

EMBEDDING CODE INTO YOUR WEBSITE

Have you see the cool page counters or perhaps a VOKI on someone's website and wonder how they did that? Now you can do it too by following the instructions below.

Find a Web 2.0 website that offers free code for what you want to add to your webpage. The example below shows how to add a web counter.

- Find site (ie www.meriteducation.com/counters.htm)

Step 1: Click On a Education Web Counter Below:



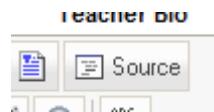
- Choose the counter you like and fill out the information to get the free code.
- You will get a screen box that has the code listed.

Copy this code onto your webpage.

- Copy the code in the box (Highlight everything by scrolling with your mouse and hit Ctrl+C)
- Go to your webpage and click on the Source button



- Place your cursor at the end of all your text and paste in the code (click CTRL +V)
- Click back on the Source button and you will see what you embedded
- If there is extra stuff listed with the code, you can edit it as you would a picture
