### FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE School year 2019-2020

**Pendleton County Board of Education / Food Service** announced an amendment to its policy for serving meals to students under the **[National School Lunch / School Breakfast Programs]** starting the 2017-2018 school year.

Pendleton County School District is participating in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP).

This program allows all students attending Pendleton County Schools to receive one breakfast and one lunch daily at no charge.

Students may purchase second meals and a la carte items during meal times, but (Must have money in student account or cash in hand)

However, to determine eligibility to receive additional benefits for your child(ren) and school, please complete a "Household income form" that you receive from your school.

Pendleton County Food Service has a "No Charge Policy" district wide.

Student second meal:            Breakfast - \$1.50      Lunch - \$2.25

Adult's meal:                    Breakfast -\$2.50      Lunch - \$3.75
